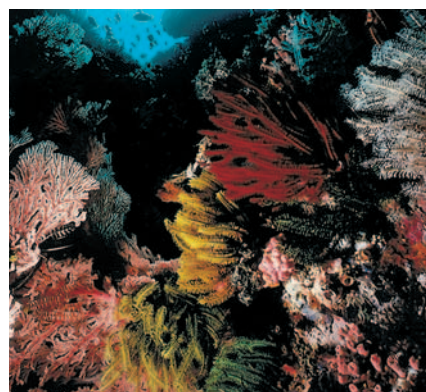
**2** Test your friend. Count and then say wrong numbers.

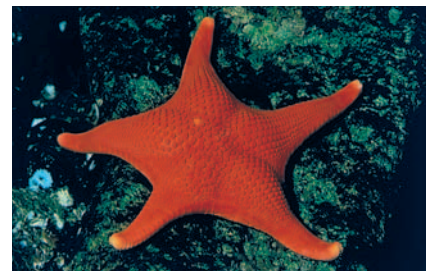
